Short bio: Paulo Costa Carvalho graduated as an engineer, has an MSc in Molecular Biology (Fiocruz), and a Ph.D. in systems engineering and computer science from the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro. Paulo is an alumnus of the Laboratory for Biological Mass Spectrometry headed by Prof. John R. Yates (h-index 196) at the Scripps Research Institute, California, EUA. Among Paulo's awards, we highlight the Google Award for Academic Excellence, the CAPES award for having his Ph.D. thesis one of the most prominent in Brazil, and, more recently, the first Brazilian to be awarded the Institute Pasteur Talent Award (2019). He is currently the head of the Laboratory for Structural and Computational Proteomics at Fiocruz Paraná; Paulo serves as a full professor at the graduate level at Fiocruz Paraná. Paulo published over 130 papers. In 2014, he became accredited into the highly competitive group of researchers officially sponsored by Brazil's Research Council, owing to the high quality of his publications. Paulo is a founding member of the Brazilian Society for Proteomics and a member of its scientific committee. In October 2014, Paulo was nominated as an executive editor of the Journal of Proteomics, the official journal of the European Proteomics Association. Paulo has earned several national and international grants; some examples are CNPq Universal, Papes Jovem Cientista, Fiocruz Inova, and Microsoft Research. He also coordinates projects with a partnership of the industry, examples being with Nitto Aveccia (USA), Nova Analítica (Brazil), and O Boticario (Brazil).
